Global top 5 competitors of each competitive event will be announced. All the participants will gain certificates of achievements according to their score range. The certificates will be sent to the advisers after the competition.

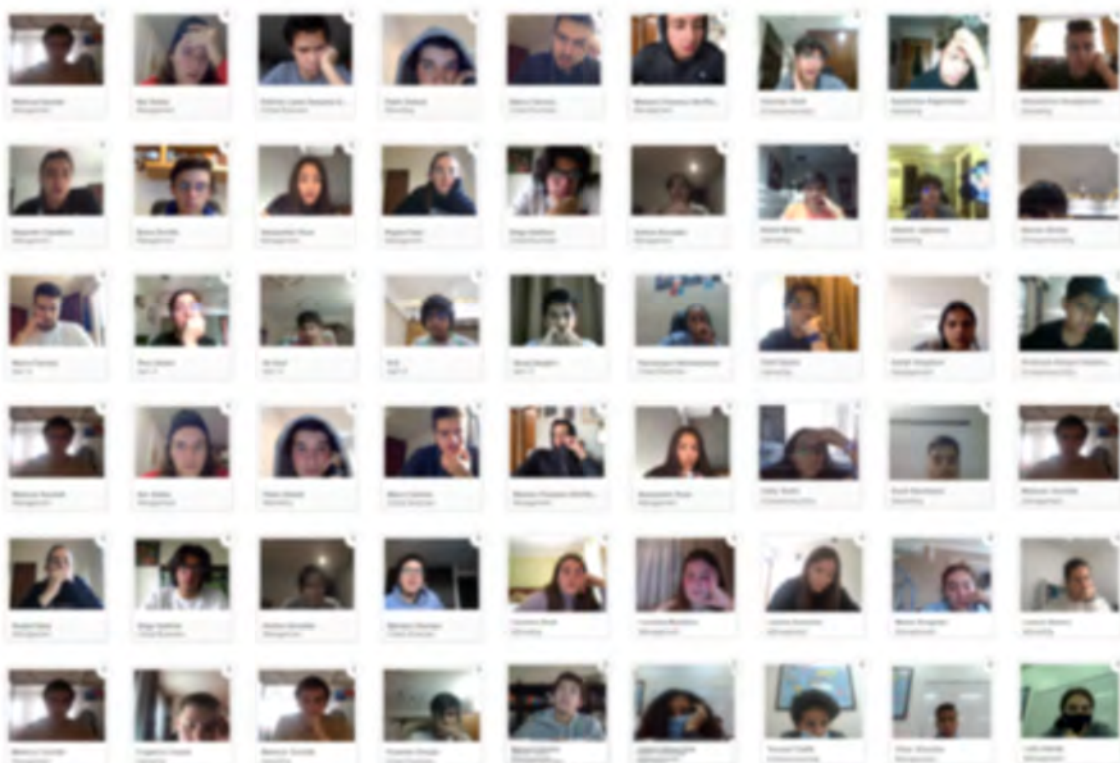

FBLA

FBLA (Future Business Leaders of America) is one of the largest student career development organizations and business literacy education organizations in the world. It is also the most influential business event in American high schools.

Students who have performed well in WFBL competition at the school level will be eligible to form a school team to take part in the FBLA competition

IBO

International Business Olympiad, (IBO) is dedicated to training a new generation of global business leaders through a full-scale Business knowledge competition. In the IBO competition, representatives of students from different countries participate in four subjects, focusing on various business cases, managing and making decisions based on their chosen project knowledge.

Well-performed students can also be qualified to form a school team to take part in the IBO competition.
